

AMENDMENT TO THE TULARE COUNTY AREA GENERAL PLAN -LAND USE ELEMENTWOODLAKE AREA GPA 80-4

I. INTRODUCTION

This document amends the 1978 Land Use Element of the Tulare County Area General Plan for the Woodlake Area.

II. SUPERSEDURE

This amendment supersedes the 1978 adopted Land Use Map and text (GPA 78-3B) for the Woodlake Area to the limited extent of designating an area for "Neighborhood Commercial" development on the east side of the community.

III. MODIFICATION TO ADOPTED ELEMENT

A "Neighborhood Commercial" area of approximately 15.47 acres is designated for the area south of Naranjo Boulevard, north of the Visalia Electric Railroad, east of Castle Rock Street, and approximately 860 feet west of St. Johns Street replacing an Agricultural designation.

IV. IMPLEMENTATION STRATEGIES

To implement the proposed change in land use from "Agricultural" to "Neighborhood Commercial", the area presently zoned "A-1" (Agricultural Zone) should be changed to "C-1" (Neighborhood Commercial).
